Instructions for the printing office

Game board:

- Size 1,000x635mm
- Poster printing, e.g. 140g
- Alternative materials for a durable game board can also be asked from the printing office.

Action cards:

- Two 2-sided A3 printouts
- 300-350g
- The cards have aligned crop marks

Perspective cards:

- Two 2-sided A3 printouts
- 300-350g
- The cards have aligned crop marks

Information cards:

- Three 2-sided A4 printouts
- 300-350g
- Cut in half, crop marks in the cards

Information for game organisers:

- One 2-sided A4 printout
- Thicker printing paper, e.g. 140g

Game tokens:

- One A4 printout
- 300-350g
- Counters can be cut into shape. There is an outline for cutting into shape in PDF if that is possible in the printing house.

Printing instructions

General:

- When printing with a photocopier, you get the best result using thicker paper than usual, 100-160g.
- Please note that most printouts are in size A3 but information cards and game tokens get printed in size A4.
- In the printing menu, always select actual size or 100% as the image size.
- It may be difficult to align 2-sided printouts (all cards). Select in the printing menu under 2-sided printout that the photocopier flips the paper on the short edge. Papers may still move about in the printer, so it is hard to get perfect alignment.
- 2-sided cards should be cut from the reverse heading side along the lines.

Game board:

- Formed of two printouts of size A3.
- NB The game board should be printed as 1-sided.
- The white edge can be cut off from the joint and fastened with tape from the behind.

Action cards:

- Two 2-sided A3 printouts
- Cut apart, best with a cutter.

Perspective cards:

- Two 2-sided A3 printouts
- Cut apart, best with a cutter

Information cards:

- Three 2-sided A4 printouts
- Cut apart, best with a cutter.

Information for game organisers:

- One 2-sided A4 printout

Game tokens:

- One A4 printout
- Counters can be cut along straight lines or into form with scissors.
